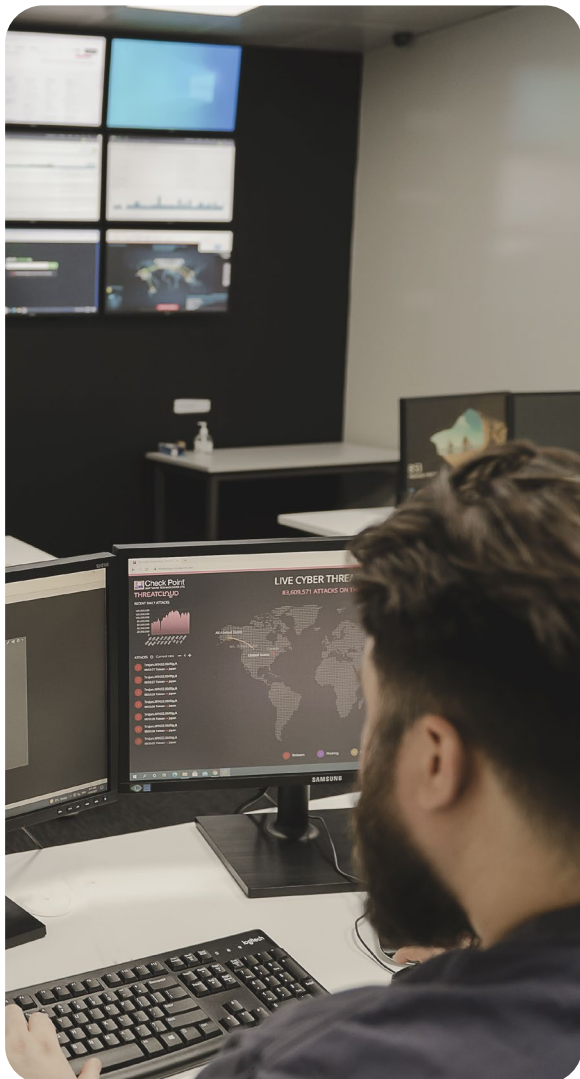

Our courses

Our cyber security courses focus on the practical and theoretical dimensions of IT security across a range of fundamental areas, such as network security and vulnerability assessment, information security, digital forensics, wireless device security and managing a SOC. We offer flexibility in our course delivery options, offering night-class, online and condensed skillsets to cater to those looking to transition into the industry while maintaining existing work commitments. Recently launched in Canberra, the new Essential Eight Assessment Course has been designed and developed by the Australian Signals Directorate (ADS)'s Australian Cyber Security Centre (ACSC) in partnership with TAFE cyber, a national consortium of ten TAFE colleges focused on skilling the fast-growing cyber security workforce through education and training.

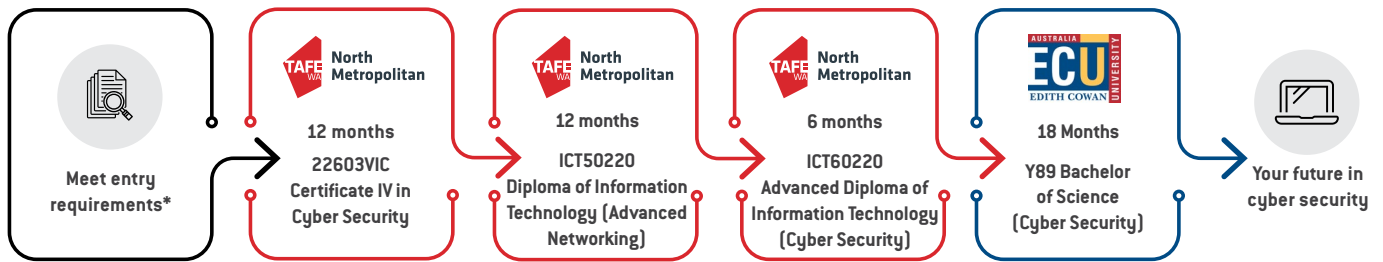
